They are passionate about working with Langhorne Creek fruit, which has an excellent reputation for consistently producing high quality wines.


From an environmental stand-point, and as a family business, Bremerton's ethos is to pass on our property in an improved environmental position for the next generation of winemakers and vignerons.

LANGHORNE CREEK

35.2963°S - 139.0383°E ALTITUDE 30M GROWING SEASON RAINFALL 140MM

One of the best-kept secrets in Australian viticulture, Langhorne Creek is one of Australia's oldest wine regions. The region is nestled among gum trees on the Bremer and Angas rivers.

Langhorne Creek is less than a one-hour drive from Adelaide.

REGIONAL WINEMAKING

Alongside its famous Cabernet Sauvignon – the powerhouse behind many of Australia's most famous red blends since the 1960s – Langhorne Creek produces full bodied Shiraz and Malbec.

Langhorne Creek Wines tend to be medium to full bodied, aromatic and fruit driven with firm, integrated tannins and persistent length. Generally the wines are immediately accessible, soft and fragrant. Flavours are in the red berry spectrum, often with gentle minty and chocolate overtones.

In recent years these classics have been joined by some of Australia's most thrilling wines being made from alternative varieties. Varieties like Fiano, Vermentino, Lagrein and Tempranillo are capturing critics' attention for their superb varietal expression as captured through the lens of Langhorne Creek's extraordinary terroir.

CLIMATE

Langhorne Creek has a cool maritime climate with a mean January temperature of 19.9°c and 1520 heat degree days. This is due to the onshore southerly winds coming off Lake Alexandrina, a 600 sq km body of fresh water at the end of the Murray Darling River system, 3 times the size of Sydney Harbour.

The wind carries its cooling effect across the lake directly from the Antarctic and Southern ocean. There is no land to warm or moderate the wind before it reaches our vines. The influence it has on our climate is dramatic; The prevailing southerlies reduce daytime temperature fluctuations, it moderates summer heat and mitigates winter frosts. The majority of rainfall occurs in winter and spring.

SOIL

Langhorne Creek's fertile soils are predominantly deep, alluvial sandy loams that vary in colour from red-brown to dark grey, with patches of black, self-mulching clays.

It is a zesty wine providing lifted aromatics balanced by a palate displaying a touch of citrus with clean acid structure and a crisp refreshing finish.

This wine has been carefully blended to provide us with a generous and well balanced palate displaying mouth filling fruit, complementing soft well-integrated tannins and a lingering finish.



"MATILDA FRECKLES"



'Matilda Freckles Willson' was the resident Border Collie dog at Bremerton Wines.

The Willson family decided to release this range of wines in honour of Matilda, for her working efforts throughout her lifetime. Over this time she was a loyal, hard-working dog in the vineyards at Bremerton. She was in charge of grape sampling because she had a great nose for ripeness and as soon as the fruit started to ripen she knew to start sampling. Matilda's favorite varieties to sample were Sauvignon Blanc and Cabernet Sauvignon, so these are the base for the two Matilda Plains Wines.

SAUVIGNON BLANC BETTY & LU

This fresh zesty Sauvignon Blanc has lifted aromas of fresh grass and citrus with a crisp refreshing palate that is complemented by lovely mouth-watering acidity.



VERDELHO MOLLIE & MERLE

A fresh, vibrant style expressing pure varietal characteristics. Lifted perfumed citrus aromas, a bright and textural palate with fine acid balance and great length of flavour.



ROSÉ RACY ROSÉ

On the palate the wine is racy and moreish, with savoury fruit, textural palate and a fine dry finish.



CABERNET / SHIRAZ / MALBEC / MERLOT TAMBLYN

The Tamblyn is a seamless blend showing a complex flavour profile with a soft tannin finish that expresses the individual characteristics of the 4 classic varietals used.

SIGNATURE RANGE



SHIRAZ SELKIRK

Our Selkirk Shiraz offers distinctive varietal characters of lifted white pepper aroma, dark berry fruit, plum and savoury spice. It displays a well-balanced palate structure, soft supple tannins and well integrated oak.



CABERNET SAUVIGNON COULTHARD

Our Coulthard Cabernet displays a classic ripe cassis aroma with supportive savoury notes and has a well balanced palate showing ripe dark fruits enhanced by a silky textural finish.

SPECIAL RELEASE RANGE



VERMENTINO

With personality & texture, this is an aromatic and bright wine, full of lemon, citrus pith and elements of sea spray character backed up with mouth watering acidity and a lingering finish.



FIANO

This wine is a modern example of Fiano and is aromatic and intensely flavoured giving fresh lifted citrus curd notes balanced by a textural nuttiness and fresh acidity.



TEMPRANILLO/GRACIANO

Berry, dark rose and spice notes frame the palate in a medium weight, juicy wine. It is well balanced and supported by fine tannins and structural acid.



MALBEC

This wine shows an intense perfumed aroma of violets and spice with a bramble lift, on the palate the wine is rich and fleshy with fine tannins.

BÂTONNAGE RANGE



CHARDONNAY

Lifted lemon curd on the nose with hints of stone fruit and spice. It shows an expressive palate, complemented by restrained oak and a creamy mouthfeel, tempered by a fine acid structure and textural finish.



SHIRAZ/MALBEC

The nose shows lifted violet and spice, complemented by a palate showing purity of varietal fruit. This red fruit and white spice is balanced by the structural complexity of fine French oak and a textural finish

PREMIUM RANGE



SHIRAZ Old Adam

The Old Adam is an excellent example of premium Langhorne Creek shiraz, showing intensity of rich fruit flavours and elegant integrated oak, providing a delicious well structured complex wine.

Every vintage, each parcel of shiraz is assessed and the most outstanding parcels of fruit are fermented in open vats and then matured for 22 months in new and seasoned specifically selected, extra fine grain American and French Oak. Additional 12 months maturation in bottle allows full integration of oak and fruit tannin.

This maintains the quality, distinction and reputation of this fine wine.



CABERNET SAUVIGNON WALTER'S RESERVE

The Walter's Reserve Cabernet is a powerful yet elegant wine, showing gorgeous varietal notes of blackberry, bramble and earth, complemented by subtle influences of chocolate and savoury nuances.

The wine is supported by a fine, defining, elegant tannin structure and shows spice and complexity. This wine is very secretive as it takes its time to reveal itself, a powerful wine that will not only evolve in the glass but will reward you with patience in the cellar.

Individual Cabernet Sauvignon parcels are matured in new and seasoned French oak barrels for 22 months. Two years additional bottle maturation allows further flavour development and tannin integration before the wine's release.



BEST OF VINTAGE

Our philosophy of ensuring separate fermentation and oak maturation of our wines reveals to us many amazing small parcels of wine which are nurtured and tasted, and often end up as secret favourites! A small selection of these exquisite individual barrels/parcels are chosen and culminate in our Best Of Vintage.

This blend of only 100 dozen, has resulted in a full flavoured and bodied wine showing generous dark fruit notes with an undertone of dried spice and earth. The fine but supportive tannins provide the wine with a refined texture and great length.
